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IFRS 17 *Insurance Contracts*Project Update

Objective

- 1 The objective of this paper is to provide:
 - (a) An update on the progress in developing a draft endorsement advice for IFRS 17 Insurance Contracts; and
 - (b) The current project plan.

A. PROJECT UPDATE

The following is a summary of progress since the conference call of the EFRAG Board on 20 March 2018.

Meetings

- There was no EFRAG IAWG meeting in March as EFRAG IAWG members did not present a sufficient number of issues for discussion. The EFRAG IAWG meeting scheduled on 26 April will include:
 - (a) papers developed for the May 2018 meeting of the IFRS 17 Transition Resource Group;
 - (b) Financial reinsurance Eligibility of reinsurance for the Variable Fee Approach;
 - (c) Acquisition costs; and
 - (d) the preliminary analysis of similarities and differences between Solvency II and IFRS 17.
- 3 IFRS 17 was not discussed at the April EFRAG TEG meeting and will not be discussed at the May EFRAG TEG webcast.

Activities

- 4 Conference and video calls with participants in the case study are continuing.
- We have been advised informally that some insurers will participate in the simplified case study. However, we are unable to estimate the likely level of responses as participants in the simplified case study are not required to formally register their participation.
- The appointed economic consultant has delivered a draft inception report (a detailed project plan and report template) on which the EFRAG Secretariat has provided comments.
- 7 In terms of the user outreach:
 - (a) we have issued the public call for participation;
 - (b) sent over 300 emails to organisations and individuals who are known to have an interest in the insurance industry to draw their attention to the public call;
 - (c) already have 18 expressions of interest in participating; and
 - (d) are working to incorporate comments and suggestions from EFRAG Board members in the outreach materials.
